

ORDINANCE NO. 4119 (Cont'd)

SECTION 4. That upon the taking effect of this Ordinance, the police, fire, and snow removal services of the City of Grand Island, Nebraska, shall include and be extended to the lands, lots, tracts, streets, and highways hereinbefore annexed and, that lands, lots, and tracts as hereinbefore annexed, not heretofore provided with the same, shall be furnished water service not later than one year after the date of this annexation.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is enacted under authority and in reliance upon Legislative Bill 338 enacted by the 73rd Session of the Legislature of Nebraska, with emergency clause as approved by the Governor of Nebraska on April 24, 1963.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication, as by law provided.
