

ORDINANCE NO. 4276 (Cont'd)

A tract of land in the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-one (21), Township Eleven (11) North, Range Nine (9) West of the 6th P.M., Hall County, Nebraska, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the west line and thirty-three (33) feet north of the southwest corner of said Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$); thence running north on the west line of said Section Twenty-one (21) for a distance of five hundred five (505) feet to the southwest corner of Lot One (1), Block Six (6) of Kay-Dee Subdivision in the Village of Parkview, Nebraska; thence running east on a south line of said Kay-Dee Subdivision for a distance of four hundred twenty-two and two tenths (422.2) feet to the southeast corner of Lot Three (3), Block Six (6) of said Kay-Dee Subdivision; thence running south on a west line of said Kay-Dee Subdivision for a distance of five hundred five (505) feet to a point thirty-three (33) feet north of the south line of said Section Twenty-one (21); thence running west on a line parallel to and thirty-three (33) feet north of the south line of said Section Twenty-one (21) for a distance of four hundred twenty-two and two tenths (422.2) feet to the point of beginning, and containing 4.895 acres more or less.

SECTION 3. That a certified copy of this ordinance, together with plats of such lands shall be filed for record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Hall County, Nebraska.

SECTION 4. Such lands are hereby annexed to the City of Grand Island, Hall County, Nebraska.

SECTION 5. That upon the taking effect of this ordinance, the police, fire, and snow removal services of such City shall be furnished to the lands hereinbefore annexed and water service is available upon petition as provided for by Section 16-668, R.R.S. 1943.

SECTION 6. That this ordinance is enacted under authority and in reliance upon Section 16-106, R. S. Supp. 1963.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in thirty days in one issue of the Grand Island Daily Independent, as by law provided.
