ORDINANCE NO. 4287 (Cont'd)

SECTION 2. That the boundaries of the City of Grand Island, Nebraska, be, and hereby are, extended to include within the corporate limits of such City the contiguous and adjacent lots, lands and streets located in the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twenty-nine (29), Township Eleven (11) North, Range Nine (9) West of the 6th P.M., Hall County, Nebraska, more particularly described as follows:

Lots One (1) through Seventeen (17) in Block One (1); Lots One (1) through Twelve (12) in Block Two (2); Lots One (1) through Nine (9) in Block Three (3); Circle Drive as platted and dedicated; all of the aforesaid Lots, Blocks and Streets being in Stewart Place Subdivision, and a tract of land eighty-five (85) feet by one hundred fifty (150) feet lying south of and parallel to the north line of said Section Twenty-nine (29) and between Lots One (1) and Two (2) of said Stewart Place Subdivision, all of the aforesaid containing 14.89 acres more or less.

SECTION 3. That a certified copy of this ordinance, together with a plat of such lots, lands and streets shall be filed for record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Hall County, Nebraska.

SECTION 4. Such lots, lands and streets are hereby annexed to the City of Grand Island, Hall County, Nebraska.

SECTION 5. That upon the taking effect of this ordinance, the police, fire and snow removal services of such City shall be furnished to the lots and lands hereinbefore annexed, and water service will be available upon petition as provided by Section 16-668, R.R.S. 1943.

SECTION 6. That this ordinance is enacted under authority of and reliance upon Section 16-106, R.S. Supp. 1963.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication within thirty days in one issue of the Grand Island Daily Independent, as by law provided.
