

ORDINANCE NO. 4297 (Cont'd)

of the east line of said Dawn Addition, also adjacent to and east of Gieses South Lawn in the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Twenty (20) and adjacent to and east of the south prolongation of the east line of said Gieses South Lawn, from thirty-three (33) feet south of the north line of said Section Twenty-nine (29) to the south right-of-way line of the Chicago, Burlington and Quincy Railroad Company Belt Line, and containing 3.0 acres more or less, the south sixty-six (66) feet to aforesaid tract also being used for a public road or street purposes.

SECTION 3. That a certified copy of this ordinance, together with a plat of such tracts of land and streets, shall be filed for record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Hall County, Nebraska.


SECTION 4. Such tracts of land and streets are hereby annexed to the City of Grand Island, Hall County, Nebraska.

SECTION 5. That upon the taking effect of this ordinance, the police, fire, and snow removal services of such City shall be furnished to the tracts of land and streets hereinbefore annexed, and water service will be available as provided by law.

SECTION 6. That this ordinance is enacted under authority of and in reliance upon Section 16-106, R.S. Supp. 1963.


