ORDINANCE NO. 4307 (Cont'd)

A tract of land in the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter ($SE_{+}^{1}SE_{+}^{1}$) of Section Twenty (20), the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter ($SW_{+}^{1}SW_{+}^{1}$) of Section Twenty-one (21), the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter ($NW_{+}^{1}NW_{+}^{1}$) of Section Twenty-eight (28), and the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter ($NE_{+}^{1}NE_{+}^{1}$) of Section Twenty-nine (29), all in Township Eleven (11) North, Range Nine (9) West of the 6th P.M., Hall County, Nebraska, more particularly described as follows:

That part of the County Road, also known as Stolley Park Road, being sixty-six (66) feet in width, of which the north one-half (N_2^+) of said road is the south thirty-three (33) feet, except the west thirty-three (33) feet, of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE $_4^+$) of said Section Twenty (20), and the south thirty-three (33) feet of the west four hundred twenty-two (422) feet of the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW $_4^+$ SW $_4^+$) of said Section Twenty-one (21); and the south one-half (S $_2^+$) of said road is the north thirty-three (33) feet, except the west thirty-three (33) feet, of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NE $_4^+$ NE $_4^+$) of said Section Twenty-nine (29), and the north thirty-three (33) feet of the west five hundred forty-four and seven-tenths (544.7) feet of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NW $_4^+$ NW $_4^+$) of said Section Twenty-eight (28), and containing 2.691 acres more or less.

SECTION 3. That a certified copy of this ordinance, together with a plat of such street or road, shall be filed for record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Hall County, Nebraska.

SECTION 4. Such street is hereby annexed to the City of Grand Island, Hall County, Nebraska.

SECTION 5. That upon the taking effect of this ordinance, the police, fire, and snow removal services of such City shall be furnished to the street or road hereinbefore annexed.

SECTION 6. That this ordinance is enacted under authority of and in reliance upon Section 16-106, R.S. Supp. 1965.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication within thirty days in one issue of the Grand Island Daily Independent, as by law provided.
