west line of said Section Eleven (11) for a distance of two thousand six hundred seven (2,607) feet more or less to the south line of the Northwest Quarter of said Section Eleven (11); thence continuing south on a line parallel to and thirty-three (33) feet east of the west line of said Section Eleven (11) to its intersection with the northeasterly prolongation of the southerly line of Fourth (4th) Street in the City of Grand Island, Nebraska; thence running southwesterly on the northeasterly prolongation of the southerly line of said Fourth (4th) Street to the west line of said Section Eleven (11); thence running north on the west line of said Section Eleven (11) to the northwest corner of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Eleven (11); thence running west on the south line of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Ten (10) for a distance of thirty-three (33) feet; thence running north on a line parallel to and thirty-three (33) feet west of the east line of said Section Ten (10) for a distance of two thousand six hundred seven (2,607) feet to the point of beginning and containing 4.0 acres more or less.

SECTION 3. That a certified copy of this ordinance, together with plat of such street or road, shall be filed for record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Hall County, Nebraska.

SECTION 4. Such street is hereby annexed to the City of Grand Island, Hall County, Nebraska.

SECTION 5. That upon the taking effect of this ordinance, the police, fire, and snow removal services of such City shall be furnished to the street or road hereinbefore annexed.

SECTION 6. That this ordinance is enacted under authority of and in reliance upon Section 16-106, R. S. Supp. 1965.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication within thirty days in one issue of the Grand Island Daily Independent, as by law provided.
