

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable perally, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a tion in tavor of the United States upon all property and rights to preparty, whether real or personal, belonging to such orron.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed for a judgment against the taxpayer arising dut of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.
