common, with right of survivorship Second Party.

WITNESSETH: That First Party for and in consideration of the sum of

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has sold and by these presents does grant, convey and confirm
unto the Second Party and to Second Party's heirs and assigns or to heirs and
assigns of the survivor of them, forever, lot number 270
spaces 1, 2-3 and 4 section "B" of WESTLAWN MEMORIAL PARK
of Grand Island, Nebraska, situated in Hall County, Nebraska, a cemetery to be used for interment pur-
poses only, being so dedicated and declared, the Plat of said cemetery being recorded in the office of the
Register of Deeds of Hall County, Nebraska.

This deed is subject to all laws of the State of Nebraska, and to all by-laws, rules and regulations
of WESTLAWN MEMORIAL PARK CEMETERY of Grand Island, Nebraska, and to any changes in said
laws, by-laws, rules and regulations.

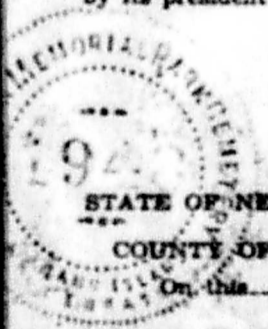
Any transfer of title of any part of the above described property shall not be valid until the same

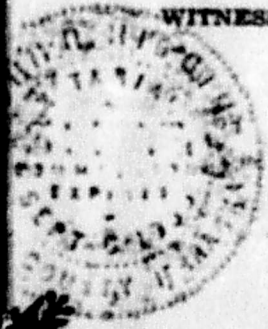
