Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest additional amount, addition to tax or assessable penalty together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in tavor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically toxed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shaft arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons

- (a) Purchasors, Molders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lieners, And Judgment Lien Creditors.—The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser holder of a security interest mechanic's liener or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filled by the Secretary
- (b) Protection For Certain Interests Even Though Notice Filed.—Even though notice of a lien imposed by section 6321 has been filed, such lien shall not be valid— (1) Place For Fillian Methon: Form
- (f) Place For Filing Notice: Form —

- (B) Willi Clerk Of District Court—In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A) or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District of Columbia —In the office of the Recorder of Jeeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia.

(2) Situs Of Property Subject 1o Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4) property shall be deemed to be situated—

(A) Real Property — in the case of real property, at its physical location, or

(B) Personal Property—In the case of personal property whether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the time the notice of lien is filled. For purposes of paragraph (2)(B), the residence of a corporation or partnership shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive office of the business is located, and the residence of a taxpayer whose residence is without the United States shall be deemed to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form —The form and content of the notice referred to it subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary Such notice shall be valid notwithstanding any other provision of two regarding the form or content of a notice of lien.

- (g) Refiling Of Notice For purpose of this section-
- (1) General Rule —Unless notice of lien is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filled (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refiling period
- (2) Place For Filling.—A notice of lier, refilled during the required refilling period shall be effective only.

(A) If such notice of iten is refiled in the office in which the prior notice of iten was filed, and

(B) In any case in which 90 days or more prior to the date of a refilling of notice of lien under subparagraph (A) the Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer is residence if a notice of such

lien is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located. (3) Required Roffling Period.—in the case of any notice of lien, the term required refiling period means.

 (A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expression of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the lax and

B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required refiling period for such notice of tien.

Sec 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property

(a) **Release Of Line** — Subject to such requisitions as the Secretary may prescribe the Secretary shall insure a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the pay on which—

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed together with all interest in respect thereof has been fully satisfied or has become regally unenforceable or

(2) Bond Accepted - There is turnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed together with all interest in respect thereof within the time prescribed by law including any extension of such time; and that is in accordance with such requirements relating to terms, conditions and form of the bond and sureties thereon, as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103 Confidentiality and disclosure of returns and return information

(k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes —

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien. If notice of lien has been filled pursuant to section 6323:1 the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who turnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such senior intends to obtain a right in such property.
