



DESCRIPTION

Plot of a tract of land in the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section Eleven (11) Township Eleven (11) North, Range Ten (10) West of the 6th P.M., Hall County, Nebraska, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the east line of said NE 1/4; said point being Five Hundred Fifty (550.0) feet south of the northeast corner of said NE 1/4, said point also being the southeast corner of SUNSET SECOND SUBDIVISION, thence running westerly along and upon the south line of said NE 1/4 a distance of One thousand Three Hundred Twenty (1320.0) feet; thence running southerly and parallel to the east line of said NE 1/4 a distance Two Hundred Twenty Four (224.0) feet thence running easterly and parallel to the north line of said NE 1/4 a distance of One Thousand Three Hundred Twenty (1320.0) feet to a point on the east line of said NE 1/4; thence running northerly along and upon the east line of said NE 1/4 a distance of Two Hundred Twenty Four (224.0) feet to the point of beginning and containing 6.788 acres more or less.
