ORDER APPROVING FINAL ACCOUNT
AND DECREE OF DISTRIBUTION
AND DISCHARGE OF EXECUTOR

Now on this 5th day of March, 1953, this cause came on for hearing upon the Final Account and upon the Petition for Decree of Distribution and Discharge of Executor and was submitted to the Court. Upon due consideration whereof, the Court, having examined the records and files herein, including the Final Account, and having heard the evidence in support thereof and being fully advised in the premises, finds that:

1. Due and legal notice of said hearing has been given to all persons interested, as required by law.
2. The Final Account is true and correct in all respects, and it is hereby approved and allowed as the final account of the executor.
3. Due and legal notice was given to all creditors and to all persons having claims against the estate, by publication in the Grand Island Daily Independent for three successive weeks, as required by law, and a decree forever barring and excluding claims against the estate was duly entered herein, on the 17th day of November, 1952.
4. Only three claims have been filed against said estate, which claims are as follows, to-wit: the claim of the Paine Monument Company, in the sum of \$10.00; the claim of Dr. W. D. McGrath, in the sum of \$115.00; and, the claim of the Treasurer of Hall County, Nebraska, in the sum of \$5.94, which three claims were duly allowed and have been paid in full by the executor. An additional claim of the Treasurer of Hall County in the sum of \$37.55 was subsequently filed, allowed and paid in full. All expenses connected with the funeral and last illness of the deceased have also been paid. All other expenses of the estate have been paid except Court
