Now on this 17th day of January, 1962, this cause came
on for hearing on the Final Report filed herein by John H. Schleicher,
Administrator of the estate of John Pfennig, deceased, and upon his
Petition for the approval and allowance of said report, settlement of
said estate, determination of heirs, and his discharge herein, and
the Court having examined the records, and being fully advised in the
premises find:

That John H. Schleicher filed his Petition in this Court on
March 15, 1962, alleging, among other things, that John Pfennig
departed this life intestate on 17th day of January, 1962,
and that he was at that time, a resident and inhabitant of said
county and state and the owner of an estate to be administered in
said county; that upon filing and reading of said petition, an or-
der was entered fixing the time and place for hearing the evidence
in support of said petition, giving notice thereof to all interested
parties by publishing said notice for three (3) successive weeks in
the Grand Island Daily Independent, a legal newspaper published and
circulated in said county;

That said hearing was held as heretofore ordered by the Court
as by law required, and letters of administration were granted to
John H. Schleicher, upon filing his bond in this Court as by law
required;

That due and legal notice has been given to all persons of the
time and place fixed by the Court for filing claims against said
estate by publication for three (3) successive weeks in the Grand
Island Daily Independent, as provided by law, that all persons having
claims against said estate not filed within the time fixed by the
Court, if any such there be, should be forever barred, and enjoined
from setting up or asserting any such claim against said estate;

That the said John Pfennig departed this life leaving no widow,
and having pre-deceased him and leaving as his heirs at law and only
heirs of the deceased:
