

**LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF
GRACE E. DODD, KEARNEY, NEBRASKA**

I, Grace E. Dodd of Kearney, Buffalo County, Nebraska, do hereby make, publish and declare this to be my Last Will and Testament in words and figures following, revoking all former Wills by myself made.

1. I direct the payment of all my debts and funeral expenses.

2. In case of my death, I herewith devise and bequeath to my daughter, Opal Taylor, my city property located in Kearney, Buffalo County, Nebraska, at 1511 Central Avenue, consisting of house and three lots. I further bequeath to my daughter the said Opal Taylor all household furnishings and fixtures now located in or about said house and premises.

3. To Anns Charleston for services performed, I bequeath the amount of \$500.00 (five hundred dollars) in cash.

4. All the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, real or personal, which I have at my death and wherever situated I give, devise and bequeath to my daughters Opal Taylor and Viola Mattson, share and share alike.

5. I direct that Herman Mattson of Kearney, Nebraska, act as executor of this Will.
