At a Session of the County Court held in and for said County of Hall in the State of Nebraska, this 22nd day of October, 1952,

BE IT REMEMBERED that on the 23rd day of September, 1952, Hugo Pieper, Executor under the Last Will and Testament of Anna Pieper, deceased, filed in this Court his final account as such executor and a petition praying that said account be allowed, for a decree of heirship, a determination of inheritance tax, an order of distribution, a final settlement thereon and discharge.

For these purposes the 22nd day of October, 1952, at 10 o'clock a. m., at the County Court Room in said County was assigned as the time and place for hearing said petition, examining and allowing said account, and it was ordered that notice of the pendency of said petition and hearing thereon be given to all persons interested in said estate by publishing such notice in the Grand Island Independent, a legal newspaper printed in said County, for three weeks prior to said day of hearing, and it appears by proof on file that notice was given as ordered by Court and that no objections to said final account have been made or filed.

Upon examination of the record and the evidence in this matter and being duly advised in the premises, the Court finds as follows:

FIRST

That Anna Pieper departed this life on the 1st day of April, 1952, in Grand Island, Hall County, Nebraska, testate, and at the time of her death she was a resident of Hall County, Nebraska;

SECOND

That on the 12th day of April, 1952, Hugo Pieper filed in this Court an instrument purporting to be the last Will and Testament of said Anna Pieper, deceased, wherein said petitioner was named executor, and a petition offering said Will for probate, and on the 12th day of April, 1952, an order of this Court was made therein assigning the 7th day of May, 1952, at 10 o'clock a. m., in the County Court Room in said County as the time and place for hearing said petition, proving said Will and admitting the same to probate and ordering that notice of the pendency of said petition and hearing thereon be given to all persons interested in said matter by
