and the said Hugo Pieper named in said Will was appointed executor thereof upon furnishing bond in the sum of \$3,000.00 as ordered by this Court, which bond was furnished and approved; the Court further finds that said Anna Pieper, at the time of her death, was a widow and that she left the following heirs-at-law and only heirs-at-law, to-wit:

Anna Pieper, a daughter,
 Dora Pieper, a daughter,
 Hugo Pieper, a son, and
 Adele Polos, a daughter.

all of whom were over the age of twenty-one years at the time of the death of said decedent.

FOURTH

The Court further finds that on the 7th day of May, 1952, an order of this Court was made allowing creditors three months from and after the 1st day of June, 1952, in which to file their claims against said estate and said executor one year in which to settle said estate, and further ordering that notice to creditors be published in the Grand Island Independent, a local newspaper published and circulating in Hall County, Nebraska, for three weeks prior to the 1st day of June, 1952, and that a hearing on claims filed against said estate would be held at the office of the County Judge of Hall County, Nebraska, on the 5th day of September, 1952, at 9 o'clock a. m., and it appears by proof on file that notice of said order was published as ordered by this Court.

FIFTH

The Court further finds that on the 7th day of May, 1952, said Hugo Pieper, Executor of said estate, filed in this Court his inventory of the property of said estate, and that according to said inventory, said deceased died seized and possessed
