FINAL DECREE

At a Session of the County Court held in and for said County of Hall in the State of Nebraska this 22nd day of October, 1952.

Present: Charles Bappert, County Judge.

BE IT REMEMBERED that on the 26th day of September, 1952, Otto F. Zlonke, Jr., Executor under the Last Will and Testament of Otto F. Zlonke, deceased, filed in this Court his final account as such Executor and a petition praying that said account be allowed, for a decree of heirship, determination of inheritance tax, an order of settlement and distribution, a final settlement thereon and discharge.

For these purposes, the 22nd day of October, 1952, at 10 o'clock a. m., at the County Court Room in said County was assigned as the time and place for hearing said petition, examining and allowing said account, and it was ordered that notice of the pendency of said petition and hearing thereon be given to all persons interested in said estate by publishing such notice in the Grand Island Independent, a local newspaper printed in said County, for three weeks prior to said day of hearing; and it appears by proof on file that said notice was given as ordered by Court and that no objections to said final account have been made or filed.

Upon examination of the record and the evidence in this matter and being duly advised in the premises, the Court finds as follows:

FIRST

That Otto F. Zlonke departed this life on the 2nd day of December, 1940, at his residence in Grand Island, Hall County, Nebraska, testate, and at the time of his death he was a resident of Hall County, Nebraska;

SECOND

That on the 6th day of December, 1940, Otto F. Zlonke, Jr., calling Voss, Sam B. Zlonke, Herman Zlonke, Alfred E. Zlonke, Lucille Zlonke, and Amanda R. Herzolsheiner, filed in this Court an instrument purporting to be the Last Will and Testament of said Otto F. Zlonke, deceased, wherein said Otto F. Zlonke, Jr., was named Executor, and a petition offering said Will for probate,
