

LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF JAMES STARKEY

I, James Starkey, of Grand Island, Hall County, Nebraska, being of sound mind and memory, do make and publish this my last will and testament, in manner and form following, to wit:

Article I.

I direct that all of my just debts and the expenses of my funeral be first paid.

Article IV.

I bequeath to my said son, Lawrence Starkey, the sum of Five hundred dollars (\$500.00) and to my said son, William Starkey, the sum of Five hundred dollars (\$500.00) and to my said wife, Edna Starkey, the sum of Five hundred dollars (\$500.00) to be paid to each of them respectively at the time of my death.

Article V.

All of the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, both real and personal and wherever situated, I give, devise and bequeath to my said son, Lawrence Starkey, John Starkey, William Starkey, William Starkey, and to my wife, Edna Starkey, if any of them are alive. If any of the aforesaid named in this will should predecease me, then the wife or children of such deceased shall take his or her share.
