FINAL DECREE

DORCAS STARKEY, DECEASED

Now on this 29th day of October, 1952, this matter came on before the Court for hearing upon the final report of the executor and upon his petition, praying that said report and account be allowed, for a decree of heirship, an order of distribution, and a determination of any inheritance tax due and owing in this said estate and for final settlement and discharge of the executor, and the Court, after having examined said final report and account, together with the records and files, and being fully advised in the premises, finds that due and legal notice has been given to all persons interested in this said estate of the time and place fixed for hearing upon said final account and petition as ordered by the Court, and no one appearing to object thereto, the Court examined the same, together with the receipts and vouchers and the testimony in support thereof, and after being fully advised in the premises, finds as follows:

That Dorcas Starkey departed this life on the 30th day of December, 1931, a resident of Hall County, Nebraska;

That thereafter, and on the 10th day of January, 1952, a duly verified petition was filed in this Court praying for the allowance and probate of an instrument purporting to be the last will and testament of such Dorcas Starkey, deceased, and on the 10th day of January, 1952, an order of this Court was made herein setting and assigning the 6th day of February, 1952, in the County Court Room in such county, as the time and place for hearing upon said petition and ordering that notice of the pendency of said petition and the hearing thereon be given to all persons interested by publishing said notice in the Grand Island Daily Independent, a legal newspaper printed in said county, for three successive weeks prior to the day of said hearing. That such notice was duly given and on said date, February 6, 1952, such document was duly proven, allowed, and admitted to probate as and for the last will and testament of Dorcas Starkey, deceased.
