

5. That the said Emmett G. Bloyd died seized and possessed of Lot Two (2), Block Eleven (11), Bonnie Brae Addition to the City of Grand Island, Nebraska, which premises were held in the name of Emmett Bloyd, and which according to law descends one-fourth to the widow, Lila Bloyd, three-eighths to Beverly J. Bloyd and three-eighths to Lucille Elisabeth Bloyd, subject, however, to the right of homestead of the widow, Lila Bloyd.

IT IS, THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT;

I.


That the report of Lila Bloyd, administratrix, filed herein, be and the same be hereby in all things approved and allowed as and for her final account and in full settlement of her trust; that the balance of \$203.50, in her hands, shall be applied to the payment of court costs and costs of administration; that upon filing receipts for the same, the administratrix be discharged, and she and her surety released from all further liability on their official bond.

II.

That Emmett G. Bloyd died intestate, on April 27, 1952, a resident of Hall County, Nebraska; that he left surviving him Lila Bloyd, his widow, and a daughter, Beverly J. Bloyd, born November 8, 1936, and a daughter, Lucille Elisabeth Bloyd, born March 28, 1946, who are the sole and only heirs of his estate, and that the widow, Lila Bloyd, is the mother of only one of the two children; that the said Emmett G. Bloyd died seized and possessed of Lot Two (2), Block Eleven (11), Bonnie Brae Addition to the City of Grand Island, Nebraska, which premises are held in the name of Emmett Bloyd, and which descends to and hereby is assigned as follows: one-fourth to the widow, Lila Bloyd, three-eighths to Beverly J. Bloyd and three-eighths to Lucille Elisabeth Bloyd, subject, however, to the right of homestead of the widow, Lila Bloyd.
