ANNA SCHOOL, DECEASED

FINAL DECREE

Now on this 10th day of December, 1952, this cause came on for hearing upon the Final Report of Helen Marth and Olga Fagge, Administratrices of the estate of Anna School, deceased, and upon the Petition of said Administratrices for the allowance and approval of said Report, a settlement thereof and their discharge herein, and the Court being fully advised in the premises finds that due and legal notice has been given to all persons of the time and place fixed by the court for the hearing upon said Final Report and there being no objections thereto, and the Court having examined the same, together with the vouchers on file, finds that said Report is true and that it ought to be approved and allowed as their Final Report, said estate settled and closed and the Administratrices discharged and their sureties released from all their liability.

The Court further finds that the said Anna School departed this life June 11, 1928 and that at the time of her death she was a resident and inhabitant of Hall County, Nebraska; that she died intestate; that a Petition for letters of administration was duly filed asking that said estate be admitted to probate, that letters of administration be issued to the Petitioners, Helen Marth and Olga Fagge of Grand Island, Nebraska, daughters of the deceased, upon the goods, chattels, real estate, rights and credits of said Anna School, deceased, and that upon a hearing held thereon, after notice was duly given to all persons interested in said estate, the same was admitted to probate on July 16, 1928, and letters of administration were duly issued by this Court to the said Helen Marth and Olga Fagge on the estate.

The Court further finds that due and legal notice has been given to all persons
