FINAL DECREE

Now on this 24th day of November, 1933, being the date to which the hearing on the Final Report was continued, this cause came on to be heard on the Final Report of the Executors, and now the Court, after having examined the records and files in this cause, finds that no objections have been filed to said Final Report, and the Court after having examined the same and taken evidence, finds that the same is in all things true and correct and the same should be approved.

The Court further finds that the expenses of last illness and funeral expenses have been paid in full; that all claims filed have been paid in full; that notice of the time fixed for filing claims has been given in the manner and form provided by law and that said time has long since expired.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that all claims not now on file be and the same are hereby forever barred.

The Court finds that Anna Meyer, Executrix, has waived her fees as executrix, but that she is entitled to the sum of \$11.33 for miscellaneous executors' expenses and the same is hereby ordered paid. The Executors are hereby ordered to pay Julius Jechsch the sum of \$116.71 in full for his Executors' fees, and the court costs in the sum of \$ 99.15, including a fee of \$15.00 to the Inheritance Tax Appraiser, and the Executors are hereby allowed an attorney fee in the sum of \$991.00 to be paid to the attorney
