IN THE MATTER OF THE ESTATE OF
FREDERICK HERBERT COLWELL, DECEASED.

JUDICIAL DECREE

Now on this 7th day of January, 1953, this cause came on for hearing
and I, the undersigned Final Report
ing upon the Final Report filed herein by Hazel F. Huston, Administratrix
of said estate and upon her Petition for approval and allowance of said
report, settlement of said estate, determination of heirs, and her dis-
charge herein; and the court having examined the records and being fully
advised in the premises, finds:

That Hazel F. Huston, daughter of the deceased, filed a Petition in
this court on June 21, 1952, which was filed by all of the children al-
leged among other things that Frederick Herbert Colwell died in testate
on June 16, 1952; that at the time of his death he was a resident of said
county and state and the owner of an estate to be administered in said
county; that the Petition prayed that Hazel F. Huston be appointed Admin-
istratrix of said estate; that upon reading said Petition and taking evi-
dence thereon, an order was entered fixing the time and place for hearing
the evidence in support of said petition; that notice of said hearing was
given to all interested parties by publishing said notice for 3 successive
weeks in the Grand Island Daily Independent, a legal newspaper published
and circulated in said county; that said hearing was had as by law re-
quired; that letters of administration were granted to Hazel F. Huston,
upon the filing of her bond in this court, as by law required.

The Court further finds that due and legal notice has been given to
all persons of the time and place fixed by the court for the filing of
claims against the estate, by publication for 3 successive weeks in the
Grand Island Daily Independent, that all persons having claims against said
estate, not filed within the time fixed by said court, if any such there be,
should be forever barred, excluded, and enjoined from setting up and
asserting any claims against said estate.

The court further finds that the deceased, at the time of his death,
left no widow, she having pre-deceased him; that he left as his heirs at
law and only heirs at law and next of kin, the following:

Katie L. Moore, daughter, North Latte, Nebraska,
Hazel F. Huston, daughter, Grand Island, Nebraska,
F. Herbert Colwell, son, Trenton, New Jersey,
Frances Uribus Searson, daughter, Grand Island, Nebraska,

all of legal age.
