

LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT
OF
CARL FREDERICK SPETHMANN

I, Carl Frederick Spethmann, of Garden City, in the County of Finney, in the State of Kansas, of lawful age and being of sound and disposing mind and memory, and not under any restraint, do hereby make and publish this, my last will and testament, hereby revoking any and all former wills, by me at any time made.

FIRST: I order and direct that all of my just debts and funeral expenses be paid as soon as practicable after my decease, and that the monument for the graves of my deceased wife and myself be completed and the date of my death inscribed thereon.

SECOND: I bequeath to Mr. and Mrs. E. W. Augustine, of Grand Island, Nebraska, my diamond ring.

FIFTH: I give and bequeath to Mrs. E. W. Augustine, Grand Island, Nebraska, the following pieces of wrought iron hand fashioned by myself: candelabra consisting of three pieces, to-wit: centerpiece and two (2) matching candlestick holders; also Console (marble top) and large mirror in frame matching the aforesaid Console.

SIXTH: I give and bequeath to the persons and organizations named below the sums of money indicated opposite their respective names or designations; if they be living, or legally existing at the time of my death; but if they should predecease me, or should not be legally existing at the time of my death, it is my desire that such sums of money which would have been bequeathed to such persons or organizations, not so living or legally existing, shall be included in the residue of my estate and disposed of as provided in the residuary clause of this, my last will and testament:

SEVENTH: I order and direct the executor hereinafter named of this, my last will and testament, at his discretion, to sell and convert to cash all the rest, residue and remainder of my estate and property, real, personal and mixed, which I may own, or shall have acquired, at the time of my decease, including land, town lots, buildings, stock in corporations, leases, money in banks, whether on deposit or otherwise, claims of any kind or character, policies of life insurance, including the policies which I now hold with New York Life Insurance Company and Bankers Life Insurance Company of Des Moines, Iowa, automobiles, and all and every interest that I possess at the time of my decease in and to property of any and every kind whatsoever; and I further authorize and empower my executor to make, execute and deliver any and all deeds, contracts, bills of sale or other instruments of transfer, and any other writings necessary to pass a proper title to the same.

EIGHTH: I further order and direct that the total proceeds from the sale of the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, as directed in paragraph five of this, my last will and testament, after distribution of all of the above listed specific bequests has been made, shall be distributed in the following manner, to-wit:
