

County Court Room in said County at the time and place for hearing said Petition, proving said Will and admitting the same to probate and ordering that notice of the pendency of said petition and hearing thereon be given to all persons interested in said matter by publishing said notice in the Grand Island Independent, a legal newspaper printed in said County, for three successive weeks prior to said day of hearing, and it appears by proof on file that notice of said order was so given.

### THIRD

The Court further finds that on the 21st day of August, 1952, said instrument was proven, allowed and admitted to probate as the Last Will and Testament of said John Kehn, deceased, which last Will and Testament is in words as follows:

#### \* LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT

I, John Kehn, of Grand Island, Nebraska, being of sound mind and disposing memory, do hereby make, publish and declare this my Last Will and Testament, in words as follows:

#### I

I hereby appoint our son, Sam Kehn, Executor of this Will and direct that he pay out of my estate as soon as may conveniently be done the expenses of my last illness and burial and purchase a suitable burial plot for myself and my wife, in the event that I shall not have previously done so, and have erected at my grave and at the grave of my wife if she shall then be dead and I shall not previously have done so, suitable headstones, and to pay for all of the same out of my estate; I further direct my Executor to pay all debts legally enforceable against my estate as soon as may conveniently be done.

#### II

I hereby devise and bequeath all the rest, residue and remainder of my estate of every nature whatsoever, wherever situate, unto my dear wife, Elisabeth Kehn, should she survive me; in the event that she precede me in death, then I hereby devise and bequeath all of said rest, residue and remainder of my estate, share and share alike, unto our six children, namely: Walter Kehn, Lee Kehn, Harold Kehn, Sam Kehn, Lydia Speck and Florine Cook, to them and to their respective heirs forever.

#### III

I hereby revoke any and all former Wills and instruments of a testamentary nature heretofore made by me.
