

## FIFTH

The Court further finds that on the 21st day of August, 1952, said Sam Kehn, Executor of said estate, filed in this Court his Inventory of the property of said estate, and that according to said inventory, said deceased died seized and possessed of the following described property, to-wit:

REAL ESTATE OWNED SOLELY BY DECEASED

An undivided one-half interest in Lot Five (5) in Block One Hundred forty-five of Union Pacific Railway Company's Second Addition to Grand Island, in Hall County, Nebraska;

Lot Two (2) in Block One Hundred Forty-five of Union Pacific Railway Company's Second Addition to Grand Island, in Hall County, Nebraska;

Lot Six (6) in Block One Hundred Forty-five of Union Pacific Railway Company's Second Addition to Grand Island, in Hall County, Nebraska;

Fractional Block two (2) of Joehnek's Addition to the City of Grand Island, in Hall County, Nebraska.

REAL ESTATE OWNED JOINTLY WITH OTHERS

Lots one (1) and Two (2) in Block Three (3) in Joehnek's Addition to the City of Grand Island in Hall County, Nebraska, owned by said John Kehn and Elisabeth Kehn as Joint Tenants, not as tenants in common, with right of survivorship between them;

Lot Eight (8) in Block Ten (10) of Joehnek's Addition to the City of Grand Island in Hall County, Nebraska, owned by said John Kehn, and Elisabeth Kehn as Joint Tenants, not as tenants in common, with right of survivorship between them;

Fractional Lots Three (3), four (4) and Five (5) in Fractional Block Three (3) of Joehnek's Addition to the City of Grand Island, Nebraska, and Lot L in Joehnek's Subdivision to Grand Island, Nebraska, being a triangular tract on the westerly side of Fractional Lot Five (5) in fractional Block Three (3) of Joehnek's Addition to Grand Island, Nebraska, owned by said John Kehn and Elisabeth Kehn as Joint Tenants, not as tenants in common, with right of survivorship between them;

Lot Three (3) in Block One Hundred Forty-five (145) of Union Pacific Railway Company's Second Addition to Grand Island in Hall County, Nebraska, excepting the easterly 24 feet thereof, owned by said John Kehn and Elisabeth Kehn as Joint Tenants, not as tenants in common, with right of survivorship between them;

The easterly 24 feet of Lot Three (3) in Block One Hundred Forty-five (145) of Union Pacific Railway Company's Second Addition to Grand Island, in Hall County, Nebraska, subject to Contract for Sale thereof made August 20, 1949, by John Kehn and Elisabeth Kehn as Joint Tenants with right of survivorship between them with Aell Harris in the Original sum of \$1,500.00, payable \$30.00 upon the signing thereof and \$30.00 monthly commencing October 1, 1949, the unpaid principal to draw interest at 3% per annum from October 1, 1950, which contract is payable to said John Kehn and Elisabeth Kehn, or survivor, in which all payments have been made up to and including July 1, 1952, at the time of deceased's death which said real estate is in the name of John Kehn and Elisabeth Kehn, as Joint Tenants, not as tenants in common, with right of survivorship between them;
