IN THE MATTER OF THE ESTATE  
OF DAVID C. GIDEON, DECEASED.

Now on this 11th day of February, 1953, this cause came on for hearing upon the final report filed herein by Alvie L. Johnson, Executor of the Estate of David C. Gideon, deceased, and upon his petition for the approval and allowance of said report, settlement of said estate, determination of the heirs, and his discharge herein, and the Court having examined the records and files and being fully advised in the premises finds that due and legal notice of the time and place of the hearing on said final account and petition for discharge, has been given to all persons interested in said estate as provided by law, whereupon the Court being fully advised in the premises finds:

That the said David C. Gideon departed this life testate on or about the 17 day of June, 1952, and was at the time of his death a resident and inhabitant of said County and State and was the owner of an estate to be administered in said county.

That upon reading and filing of said petition, an order was entered fixing the time and place for hearing the evidence in support of said petition, giving notice thereof to all interested parties by publishing said notice for three successive weeks in the Grand Island Daily Independent, a legal newspaper published and circulated in said county.

That said hearing was held as heretofore ordered by the Court as by law required, and Letters Testamentary were granted to Alvie L. Johnson, upon the filing of his bond in this Court, as required by law.

That said hearing was held and an affidavit was signed by C.L. Walters, identifying the signatures of G.C. Keith, B.A. Phillips, and W.F. McConnell, that C.L. Walters was duly sworn and his affidavit filed in this Court, and the Court being fully advised in the premises finds that the signatures of G.C. Keith, B.A. Phillips, and W.F. McConnell, to the Last Will and Testament of David C. Gideon, are the genuine signatures of G.C. Keith, B.A. Phillips, and W.F. McConnell.

Said cause coming on further to be heard upon the petition for probate of the Last Will and Testament and the codicil thereto, the Court being fully advised in the premises and the proof of probate by Res. C. Gideon and R.E. Cunningham, the signature of David C. Gideon was identified as the genuine signature of David C. Gideon and said will and said codicil were admitted to probate, and Letters Testamentary were granted to Alvie L. Johnson.

The Court further finds that due and legal notice to creditors as been given and that there were no claims filed against said estate, that said estate is now solvent, and that State inheritance tax have been paid.

The Court further finds that a time and place was fixed for testing on said final report and all persons interested in said estate were notified by publication in the Grand Island Daily Independent, as provided for under the laws of the State of Nebraska.

The Court further finds that said final account of the said Alvie L. Johnson, Executor of the Estate of David C. Gideon, is in all respects just, true, and correct, and that after the payment of all debts, Court costs, executor's fees, and attorney's fees, said executor has on hand the sum of \$1851.95, which, according to the terms of the Last
