Sleuman passed away testate in Grand Island, Hall County, Nebraska, on June 16, 1952, at the age of 78 years, then being a United States citizen and a resident of Doniphan, in Hall County, Nebraska, and possessing property in said County; that said Joseph A. At the time of his death, Joseph A. Sleuman owned, by fee simple title, the following described real estate, to-wit:

which real property, together with the buildings thereon, and all personal effects, household goods, home furnishings and home appliances therein contained at the date of his death, were devised and bequeathed to Charlotte E. Adams.

7. Said Joseph E. Sleuman died leaving a Will dated October 21, 1950, and two codicils attached thereto, dated respectively March 1, 1951, and September 5, 1951, which will and codicils have heretofore been admitted to Probate.
