IN RE ESTATE No. 4186 of Claus Hass Deceased

This cause came on for hearing on the petition of Lena Hass

praying, among other things, for the probate of the instrument heretofore filed in this Court purporting to be the last will and testament of said deceased, notice having been given to all parties interested of time and place of hearing, and from the evidence adduced the Court finds that said deceased, then of sane mind and lawful age signed said written instrument on the 11th day of May, 1917

in Lancaster County Nebraska, and at the same time published and declared said instrument to be his last will and testament, in the presence of

competent persons, who at the same time attested the same and subscribed their names as witnesses thereto, in presence of and at the request of said deceased.

The Court further finds that the deceased at time of death was a resident of Lancaster County Nebraska, and died on the 25th day of July, 1917, and that the instrument offered for probate herein is the last will and testament of the deceased.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed that said instrument be admitted to probate as the last will and testament of said deceased, and that the execution of said will be committed and the administration of said estate be granted to Lena Hass

as Executor

conditioned upon her giving bond in the penal sum of \$10,000 with sufficient surety, and taking the oath of office
