

8. That said deceased died seized and possessed of the following described real estate, to-wit:

An undivided one-third interest in and to the East Half of the North-east Quarter (NE<sup>1/4</sup>) of Section Two (2), Township Nine (9), North, Range Nine (9), West of the 6th P.M., situated in the County of Hall, State of Nebraska, containing eighty (80) acres, more or less,

which should be assigned in shares of an undivided one-fourth (1/4th) interest therein to each of the heirs at law, namely: Zoe G. Rice, Robert M. Rice, Harold R. Rice and Lucille Maxine Rice Gellura.

WHEREFORE, IT IS COMMISSIONED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND ENJOINED BY THE COURT that:

1. The Final Report and Accounting of Zoe G. Rice, Administratrix herein, be and the same hereby is settled, allowed and approved.
2. The statements and allegations in the Petition and Settlement of Final Account and Distribution of the Administratrix are true and correct.
3. All claims against this estate have been paid, settled and satisfied in full.
4. The court costs, commissions due the Administratrix, and attorney fees have been properly determined, allowed and paid in full.
5. There is no inheritance tax due the State of Nebraska from any of the heirs at law of said deceased, nor is there any federal or state estate tax due.
6. Henry Ralph Rice, deceased, died intestate a resident of Hall County, Nebraska on the 27th day of March, 1952, and left as his sole and only heirs at law the following named persons, to-wit:
