

7. The Administratrix be and hereby is ordered to pay the sum of \$49.32 to Zoe G. Rice, surviving wife, \$49.32 to Robert M. Rice, son, \$49.32 to Harold R. Rice, son, and \$49.32 to Lucille Maxine Rice Collura, daughter, as the distributive shares to which each such heir is entitled after all claims and expenses have been paid and satisfied in full.

8. The real estate of which the said deceased died seized and possessed, described as, to-wit:

An Undivided one-third interest in and to the East Half of the North-east Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Two (2), Township Nine (9), North, Range Nine (9), West of the 6th P.M., situated in the County of Hall, State of Nebraska, containing eighty (80) acres, more or less,

be and the same hereby is assigned to said heirs in the shares as set out in paragraph 6 above, viz: an undivided one-fourth ($\frac{1}{4}$) interest to each of the following, namely: Zoe G. Rice, Robert M. Rice, Harold R. Rice and Lucille Maxine Rice Collura.

9. Upon the filing of receipts by the Administratrix showing payment and delivery to said heirs of the distributive shares set out in paragraph 7 herein, a formal order of discharge is to be issued to the said Administratrix and her bondsmen released.
