WHEREFORE, it is considered, ordered and adjudged by the Court that the final account of the administrator herein be and the same hereby is settled, allowed and approved; that the statements and allegations in the petition for final settlement are true and correct; that the estate has been duly administered and all claims, debts and the expenses of administration have been duly paid; that there is no inheritance tax due the State of Nebraska nor federal estate tax due the United States Government; that Anna Hanousek, deceased, died intestate on the 5th day of June, 1952, a resident of Buffalo County, Nebraska, and left as her heirs at law the persons described in paragraph 5 above; that the remaining personal property consisting of money in the hands of the administrator as set out in paragraph 6 above be and it hereby is assigned to said heirs in the shares as set out in said paragraph 6 above; that said deceased died seized of the real estate described in paragraph 7 above and that the same be and it hereby is assigned to said heirs in the shares as set out in paragraph 7 above, viz: an undivided one-fourth interest each to Edward H. Hanousek, Louis Hanousek, Blanche Eiehkoff, and Helen Skala, children of said deceased; that upon the filing of receipts by the administrator showing payment and delivery to said heirs of said money set out in paragraph 6 above, that a formal order of discharge issue to the administrator herein.
