DECREE

LETITIA THOMPSON

This matter coming on to be heard this 19th day of February, 1953, on the Petition of Letitia Thompson requesting the appointment of a conservator and membrating Einer H. Benson of Grand Island, Hebraska, and Charles E. Moyer of Ecod River, Nebraska to act as conservators:

Einer H. Benson and Charles E. Moyer were present in Court and were examined by the Court and by Harry Grimninger, attorney for the applicant; the Petitioner was not in Court due to the fact that she is just recovering from an illness aggrevated to some extent by the death of her husband.

Upon the wildence adduced the Court finds that the applicant is 84 years of age and that her husband recently passed away, that her children are not available for commutation, that the applicant is possessed of parsonal property made up of cash in the amount of approximately \$11,000.00 which will be reduced to approximately \$10,000 when all outstanding bills are paid.

The Court finds that the applicant is entitled to the appointment of a conservator; that the prayer of the Petition should be allowed; that Einar H. Benson and Charles E. Moyer are suitable and proper persons to act as such conservators.

The Court further finds that the applicant is possessed of real propertydescribed as follows:

Lot One (1) in Block Twenty-One (21), Original Town of Wood Miver, Hall County, Nebraska which real property is the homestead of the applicant. That Court further finds that it is not necessary to notify any persons or to give any notice whatever of the filing of the application.

IT IS THERESORE ORDERED, ANDURED, AND DECREED by the Court that Einer H. Benson and Charles E. Moyer are hereby appointed joint conservators of the estate of Letitia Thompson; that they shall post bond as provided by law in the amount of \$10,000; that they shall file a sertified copy of this Decree in the office of the Register of Deeds in Hall County, Hebraska; that they shall forthwith file of the Register; that all disbursements shall be made jointly by such conservators that Decree in the file of the state of the doings as such conservators shall be filedown this Owner.
