

in such estate as required by statute and filed his report herein; thereafter an order was entered herein that the executor pay to Hall County, Nebraska, the sum of \$1,946.76 upon a finding of inheritance tax due upon such estate and in such amount; the finding and order of this court and determination that such estate and the share of the sole beneficiary under the will of such decedent is subject to Nebraska Inheritance Tax in the sum of \$1,946.76 is hereby confirmed; the executor has paid such tax out of the assets of such estate as evidenced by the receipt duly filed in this court; the Nebraska inheritance Tax has been fully paid and satisfied.

It is, therefore, the finding of the court that: such estate and the sole beneficiary, Frederick Hewitt, was subject to inheritance tax under the laws of Nebraska in the amount of \$1,946.76; such sum has as provided by law been paid by the executor out of the assets of such estate; the judgment herein against such estate for Nebraska inheritance Tax is hereby decreed to be paid and satisfied in full and such estate and executor are hereby discharged from all liability for Nebraska inheritance Tax.

The Court further finds that such Edward F. Hewitt died seized of the following described real estate:

The North One-half of the Northeast quarter (N. 1/4 of Section Thirty-three (33), in Township 26 N., Range Twelve (12), in Hall County, in the State of Nebraska.

The Court further finds: That last will and testament of such Edward F. Hewitt devised such real property and the residue of his estate, remaining after his just debts, if any, expenses of burial, and costs of administering his estate, in trust, to the said Hewitt, as sole trustee, for "a period of ten years from and after" the death of such testator.

The Court further finds: Such Edward F. Hewitt died July 11, 1951, a resident and inhabitant of Hall County, Nebraska; such Hewitt, named trustee in the will of such decedent, now resides in Havana, in the State of Nebraska.

The Court further finds that the executor herein after the payment of the executor's compensation and the fees of the attorneys for the executor and such estate will have or have not the United States bonds, issued in the name of the decedent only, as described
