

in the inventory herein, and cash in the amount of \$0,050.00; the amount of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) is sufficient in amount as the penalty of the bond of the trustee herein, as required by Section 30-1801, R.R.S. 1943.

IT IS, THEREFORE, FURTHER ORDERED, CONSIDERED AND ADJUDGED that: Upon such L. C. Huxtable having qualified in this, the County Court of Hall County, Nebraska, as the trustee named in the will of Edward P. Newitt, deceased, and having given bond with sureties as required by Section 30-1801, R.R.S. 1943, the executor herein is authorized to turn over to and deliver to such trustee the real and personal property above described, and, upon the executor herein filing the receipts for payment of executor's commission, fees of the attorney for the executor in this estate, and, for the delivery of the trust property to such trustee, the executor shall be discharged from his trust as such executor and his official bond released.

It is further ordered that Roy Newitt, of Aurora, Nebraska, a brother of the decedent, is the sole and only heir-at-law of such Edward P. Newitt, deceased.
