And now the Court, after having examined the records and files, finds that said report is in all things true and correct; that the Executor has therein accounted for all of the goods and assets of the deceased which have come into his knowledge or possession and has obeyed the orders of this court.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that said Final Report be and the same is hereby approved.

The Court further finds that the time fixed for filing claims has long since elapsed and that all claims filed have been paid in full.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that all claims not now on file be and the same are hereby foreter barred.

The Court further finds that the expenses of the last illness, funeral expenses and all other charges, except those hereinafter set forth, have been paid in full.

The Court further finds that the gross value of the estate was not to exceed the sum of Thirteen Thousand Dellare.
