IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that upon filing receipts for said payments and receipts for said two five dollar gold pieces, that the Executor be discharged and his bond released.

The Court further finds that he was the owner of the afore described real estate at the time of his death.




