Now on this 26th day of November, 1952, this cause came on for hearing upon the petition of Floyd H. Runkel and Viola I. Runkel of Grand Island, Hall County, Nebraska, praying that an order be entered setting a date for hearing on said petition and that upon said hearing a Final Decree be entered in the Estate of Jesse L. Selyer, deceased.

Now after having examined said petition and the records and files in this cause, and being fully advised in the matter, the Court finds that notice of the filing of said petition has been given in the manner and foru provided by law and that no objections have been filed thereto.

The Court further finds that the allegations of the petition are true and that no Finel Decree has been entered in said estate; that the said Jesse L. Salyer died intestate on the 19th day of December, 1931, and that he was immediately preceding his death a resident and inhabitant of Grand Island, Hall County, Tebraska.

The Court further finds that administration of said estate was granted to John H. Sanders and Letters of Administration, were issued to him on the 8th day of Harch, 1932; that no money or property came into his hands or possession as administrator and that a mortgage on the real estate of Jesse L. Salver was foreclosed and said property did not bring a sufficient amount to pay said mortgage; that there was no personal property belonging to said estate.
