BE IT REMEMBERED, That on this 15th day of April A. D. 1953, at the hour of ten o'clock A. M., John E. Ray, County Judge presiding, and Anna Seehardt and Betty Ann Seehardt-Peck, joint administratrices, and John E. Willits, their attorney, and Rudolph Edward Seehardt, a son, all being present, and this hearing having been duly continued from the 18th day of March A. D. 1953, to this time at a session of this Court now comes on for final hearing upon the Final Account and Report and Supplemental Account and Report of the administratrices filed herein, and for final settlement of the administration of the estate of Henry O. Seehardt, deceased, filed herein, and the same is duly heard by the Court upon the files and records and proceedings had herein, and the evidence, and the Court finds as follows, to-wit:

1. That on the 14th day of April A. D. 1952, Anna Seehardt, the widow, and Rudolph Edward Seehardt, the son, filed a petition herein setting forth the death of Henry O. Seehardt, a resident and inhabitant of said County and State on the 7th day of April A. D. 1952, and possessed of real and personal property and estate in said County and State, and he left no last will and testament, and he left surviving him his wife, Anna Seehardt, and one son, Rudolph Edward Seehardt, and they are the sole heirs at law and only persons having interests in his estate, and praying that administration may be granted to Anna Seehardt and Betty Ann Seehardt jointly as administratrices of said estate, and thereupon an order was made for hearing on said petition on the 7th day of May A. D. 1952 at ten o'clock A. M. and that notice thereof be given by publication in the Hastings Daily Tribune, for three weeks, same being a legal newspaper of general circulation in said County.

2. That on the 7th day of May A. D. 1952 at ten o'clock A. M. after notice thereof had been published on the 21st and 28th days of April A. D. 1952, and on the 5th day of May A. D. 1952, as ordered by this court, hearing was had on the petition filed herein and Anna Seehardt and Betty Ann Seehardt were duly appointed as joint administratrices of said estate and duly qualified and Letters of Administration were duly issued to them, and thereupon an order was duly made that notice be given creditors by publication in the Hastings Daily Tribune a legal newspaper published and in general circulation in said County, to appear on or before the 15th day of September A. D. 1952, or all claims will be forever barred, said notice to be published three weeks.

3. That said notice to creditors was duly published, as ordered by this court, on the 9th, 16th and 23rd days of May A. D. 1952.

4. That on the 7th day of August A. D. 1952, inventory of said estate was duly filed by the administratrices.

5. That on the 15th day of December A. D. 1952, application was filed by the administratrices for determination of inheritance tax.

6. That on the 18th day of December A. D. 1952, and order was made that hearing for the appraisal and assessment of inheritance tax to be held on the 19th day of January A. D. 1953 at ten o'clock A. M., and notice thereof was duly given, served and acknowledged by the County Treasurer of Adams County, Clay County, Hamilton County, and Hall County, Nebraska, respectively.

7. That on the 19th day of January A. D. 1953 at ten o'clock A. M. all parties appearing hearing was had on the appraisal of the property for inheritance tax assessment.
