Willie Engel) including whatever crops may be growing thereon at the time of my death, unto my brother Frank Engel, subject however, to the payment by said Frank Engel of a pro-rata share of the expenses paid or to be paid by my Executor according to paragraph 2 above, in fee simple absolute.

B.

I hereby give, devise and bequeath unto my sisters Lena Brandt and Mary Watters, per stirpes, share and share alike, all the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, real and personal, wheresoever situated, including but not limited thereto, whatever livestock, harvested crops, and farm machinery which may be situated, at the time of my death, on the real estate hereinbefore devised to my brother Frank in paragraph 3 above, subject however, to the payment of a pro-rata share of the expenses paid or to be paid by my Executor according to paragraph 2 above.

C.

It is my express intention that rather than have the rest, residue and remainder bear the entire burden of payment of the expenses as set out in paragraph 2 above, that the real estate given to my brother Frank, also bear its proportionate share of said expenses according to the valuation said real estate bears to the value of my entire estate. For the purpose of evaluating my estate, so as to determine what pro-rata share of expenses each of my beneficiaries shall be charged with, I direct that the County Court of the County having jurisdiction of my estate, appoint three appraisers who shall by majority decision, determine the value of my real and personal property as of the time of my death.

D.

I hereby revoke all prior Wills by me made.
