FINAL DECREE

Now on this 17th day of June, 1933, this cause came on to be heard on the Final Report of Alma Sewell and Martha Olden Kaden, Executrices, and the Court after having examined the records and files in this estate, finds that notice has been given in the manner and form provided by law of the filing of said Final Report and that no objections have been filed to the same; whereupon evidence was taken, and now the Court being fully advised in the premises finds that the report of the Executrices is in all things true and correct; that they have therein accounted for all the goods and assets of the deceased which have come into their knowledge or possession, and that they have obeyed all of the orders of this court.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT that the Final Report of the Executrices be and the same is hereby ratified, approved and confirmed.

The Court finds that John Dohrn, the deceased, died testate in Hall County, Nebraska on February 14, 1933; that he was at the time of his death a citizen and resident of Hall County, Nebraska, and that this Court had jurisdiction; that he left a last Will and Testament and Codicil thereto, which last Will and Testament and Codicil have been heretofore admitted to probate and the probate has never been set aside or appealed from.

The Court further finds that the sole and only persons interested in the estate of the deceased and the only persons, who are the heirs of the said John Dohrn, are Mary Dohrn, his
