At a session of the County Court held in and for said County of Hall in the State of Nebraska, this 22nd day of July, 1953.

Present: Charles Bossert, County Judge.

BE IT REMEMBERED, that on the 26th day of June, 1953, Emma Hargens Wagner, Executrix under the Last Will and Testament of Elisa Hargens, also known as Elise Hargens, deceased, filed in this Court her final account as such executrix and a petition praying that said account be allowed, for a decree of heirship, determination of inheritance tax, an order of distribution, a final settlement thereon and discharge.

For these purposes, the 22nd day of July, 1953, at 1 o'clock a.m., at the County Court Room in said County was assigned as the time and place for hearing said petition, examining and allowing said account; and it was ordered that notice of the pendency of said petition and hearing thereon be given to all persons interested in said estate by publishing such notice in the Grand Island Independent, a legal newspaper printed in said County, for three weeks prior to said day of hearing; and it appears by proof on file that said notice was given as ordered by Court and that no objections to said final account have been made or filed.

Upon examination of the record and the evidence in this matter and being duly advised in the premises, the Court finds as follows:

FIRST

That Elisa Hargens, also known as Elise Hargens, departed this life on the 8th day of January, 1953, in Grand Island, Hall County, Nebraska, testate, and at the time of her death she was a resident of Hall County, Nebraska.

SECOND

That on the 19th day of January, 1953, Emma Wagner filed in this Court an instrument purporting to be the Last Will and Testament of said Elisa Hargens, also known as Elise Hargens, deceased, wherein said petitioner in the name of Emma Hargens Wagner, was named Executrix, and a petition offering said Will for probate, and on the 19th day of January, 1953, an order of this Court was made therein assigning the
