Litory, bebraska, and Irma Wagner Holtroeder of Grand Island, Nebraska, share and share alike.

I hereby expressly waive any privilege created under the laws of Nebraska with respect to confidential oc.munications had between me and any of the attesting witnesses to this will, and further hereby revoke any and all former wills and instruments of a testamentary nature heretofore made by me.
