

13th day of February, 1953, at 10 o'clock a.m., in the County Court Room in said County as the time and place for hearing said petition, proving said Will and admitting the same to probate, and ordering that notice of the pendency of said petition and hearing thereon be given to all persons interested in said matter by publishing said notice in the Grand Island Independent, a legal newspaper printed in said County, for three successive weeks prior to said day of hearing, and it appears by proof on file that notice of said order was so given.

THIRD

The Court further finds that on the 13th day of February, 1953, said instrument was proven, allowed and admitted to probate as the Last Will and Testament of said Elisa Hargens, also known as Elise Hargens, deceased, which Last Will and Testament is in words as follows:

" LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF ELISA HARGENS

I, Elisa Hargens, of Grand Island, Hall County, Nebraska, being of sound mind and disposing memory, do hereby make, publish and declare this my Last Will and Testament in words as follows:

I

I hereby appoint my daughter Emma Hargens Wagner, Executrix of this Will and provide that she need give no surety on her bond as such.

II

I direct my Executrix to pay out of my estate as soon as conveniently may be, the expenses of probating this Will and administering my estate, and the expenses of my last illness and burial, including a suitable marker at my grave, and also to pay all debts legally enforceable against my estate.

III

Not unmindful of my daughter Margaret Bahrs, who now resides in Germany, all the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, both real and personal, of every kind and nature and wheresoever situate, I hereby give, devise and bequeath the same unto my daughter, Emma Hargens Wagner, of Grand Island, Nebraska, in fee simple absolute, should she survive me; in the event of her death prior to the date of my decease, then only do I hereby give, devise and bequeath all of said rest, residue and remainder of my estate unto my two granddaughters, Anna Wagner Hildorf of St. Libory, Nebraska, and Irma Wagner Schroeder of Grand Island, Nebraska, share and share alike.

IV

I hereby expressly waive any privilege created under the Laws of Nebraska with respect to confidential communications had between me and any of the attesting witnesses to this Will, and further hereby revoke any and all former Wills and Instruments of a testamentary nature heretofore made by me.
