NOW on this 5th day of August, 1933 this matter came on to be heard upon the pleadings and the evidence and was submitted to the Court and upon consideration whereof the Court finds it due and legal notice of this proceedings has been given to all persons interested in said matter, both creditors and heirs, as required by law. That all of the statements and allegations set forth in said petition are true; that the said Pearl Holden died intestate in Hall County, Nebraska on the 25th day of November, 1932, a resident and inhabitant thereof, seized and possessed at the time of her death of the following described real estate, to-wit:

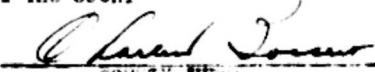
An undivided One-Half (1/2) interest in and to Lot Nine (9), and all of Lot Ten (10), in Block Five (5), Berri's & Mill's Addition to the City of Grand Island, Hall County, Nebraska

That no application has been made to the State of Nebraska for the appointment of an administrator of the estate of said deceased; that her sole and lawful heirs at law were and are John C. Holden, widower, and Sylvester S. Holden, son; Maude Holden, also known as Maude C. Holden, daughter; Edith Josephine Doty, also known as Edith Josephine Dotter, daughter; Edwin L. Holden, also known as Edwin L. Holden, son; Lawrence L. Holden, son, and Elisabeth A. Crane, also known as Elisabeth A. Crain, daughter, all over the age of 21 years, and the Court finds that the above named persons, same being the widower and children of said deceased were and are the sole and only heirs at law of said Pearl Holden, deceased, and that said real estate descended to the said John C. Holden an undivided one-third (1/3) interest therein and Sylvester S. Holden, Maude Holden, also known as Maude C. Holden, Edith Josephine Doty, also known as Edith Josephine Dotter, Edwin L. Holden, also known as Edwin L. Holden, Lawrence L. Holden, and Elisabeth A. Crane, also known as Elisabeth A. Crain, an undivided one-ninth (1/9) interest therein to each.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT that the estate above described be and the same hereby is assigned to the said John C. Holden, a one-third (1/3) interest therein, and to each of the following: Sylvester S. Holden, Maude Holden, also known as Maude C. Holden, Edith Josephine Doty, also known as Edith Josephine Dotter, Edwin L. Holden, also known as Edwin L. Holden, Lawrence L. Holden, and Elisabeth A. Crane, also known as Elisabeth A. Crain, an undivided one-ninth (1/9) interest therein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT that all claims and demands against the estate of said deceased, either due or to become due, whether absolute or contingent and the same are forever barred.
