FINAL DECREE

Now on this 12th day of August, 1963, this cause came on for hearing upon the final report filed herein by Minna Pochler, the duly appointed and acting executrix of the estate of John H. Pochler, deceased, together with the petition for approval and allowance of said report, settlement of said estate, decrees of distribution and her discharge herein, and the Court having examined the records, proceedings, and the proof on file herein, including said final report and having heard the evidence in support thereof and being fully advised in the premises finds that:

1. Due and legal notice of the time and place of this hearing has been given to all persons interested in said estate, by publication in the Grand Island Daily Independent for three successive weeks, in the manner required by law, and that no objections have been filed to said report or petition.

2. The final report is true, correct and complete in all respects; it should be approved and allowed as her final report; all of her acts and deeds as executrix should be approved; the estate should be settled and closed; receipts are on file showing payment in full for all costs and attorneys fees; and the executrix should be discharged and the liability of said executrix on her bond should be terminated and her bond released.

3. Due notice was given to all creditors and all persons having claims against said estate, of the time and place in which to file their claims, as provided by law, and such time has duly expired and an order has been entered herein barring all claims against said estate.
