- 4. No claim was filed against said estate. All expenses in connection with the funeral and last illness of John H. Pochler, deceased, have been paid in full by Minna Pochler, exceutrix, personally from funds held in survivorship between the said executrix and the said deceased, and she has voluntarily waived any right for reimburbement for same and said Minna Pochler has waived her executrix fees in this estate. Court costs, including publication fees and the attorney fees in this estate have been paid in full by the heirs personally on a pro reta basis. In accordance with the last will of said deceased, the balance on hand in the sum of \$85.00 should be assigned to the executrix.
- 5. John H. Poehler died testate on the 15th day of October, 1952, being at that time 85 years of are and being at that time a citizen and resident of Hell County, Nebraska and cossessing property in said county and state, and he left surviving him as his sole and only heirs-at-law and the sole and only beneficiaries named in his will, the following who are all of legal age, namely:

Hinna Poehler, his widow, of Hall County, Nebraska; Righard Paul Paehler, his son, of Grand Island, Nebraska; Amia Werner, a daughter, of Grand Island, Nebraska; Lena Gerner, a daughter, of Herrick County, Nebraska;

and that the said deceased left no other living children, or living issue of any deceased child or children.

- 6. At the time of his death, the said John H. Poehler was seized and possessed by fee simple title absolute of the following described real estate to-wit:
 - (1) The East Half (Ed) of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (MW1NE2) of Section Seventeen (17), in Township Twelve (12), North, Range Nine (9), West of the 6th F.M., in Hall County, Nebraska, consisting of 20 acres;
 - (2) The Southwest Quarter (SWE) of Section Eight (8), in Township Twelve (12), North, Range Hine (9), West of the 6th P.M., in Hall County, Nebraska, except 8 acres in the Southwest corner of said Southwest Quarter, formerly occupied by a church and echool, consisting of 152 acres;
