IT IS, THEREFORE, ORIENED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT that:

I.

The findings herein are hereby approved; the report of the executrix is hereby, in all things, approved, confirmed and allowed as her final account and each and every act and doing of said executrix is hereby approved.

II.

All claims against said estate have been and hereby are barred; the expenses of the last illness of said decessed have been paid in full; and all costs, including publication fees, and attorney fees have been paid in full.

III.
