**FINAL
DECREE**

IRA P. HAYFORD, deceased.

This cause came on for hearing on August 20, 1951, on the petition of Martin A. Hayford, the Administrator, for final settlement of this estate, said Administrator being present in Court in person and by Charles F. Adams, his attorney. It appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that due and legal notice of the time and place of said hearing has been given to, all persons interested in said estate by publication, as provided by law, and that no objections thereto have been filed, the matter is thereupon submitted to the Court. On consideration of the pleadings, report and account herein and the evidence, the Court, being fully advised in the premises, finds as follows:

1. That Martin A. Hayford, the Administrator herein, should be charged with the sum of \$3,779.80 and credited with the sum of \$1,516.33 and that there now remains in his hands the sum of \$2,263.47, all of which is shown by his final report herein and which constitutes the remaining personal property assets of said estate, and that his report and account as such Administrator is true and correct and should be allowed and confirmed.
2. That due and legal notice to creditors of this estate has been given by publication, as provided by law, and that no claims have been filed against this estate and that the further presentation and filing of claims against this estate to and the same is hereby forever barred.
3. That Mrs. P. Hayford, the deceased herein, died intestate on January 29, 1951, and was at the time of her death a resident of Hall County, Nebraska, and that she left surviving her as her sole and only heirs at law and
