FINAL DECREE

At a session of the County Court held in and for said County of Hall in the State of Nebraska, this 2nd day of September, 1953.

Present: Charles Bossert, County Judge.

BE IT REMEMBERED, that on the 6th day of August, 1953, Caroline S. Kosal, Executrix under the Last Will and Testament and Codicil thereto of Mattie Stromer, deceased, filed in this Court her final account as such executrix and a petition praying that said account be allowed, for a decree of heirship, determination of inheritance tax, an order of settlement and distribution, a final settlement thereon and discharge.

For these purposes the 2nd day of September, 1953, at 10 o'clock A. M., at the County Court Room in said County was assigned as the time and place for hearing said petition, examining and allowing said account; and it was ordered that notice of the pendency of said petition and hearing thereon be given to all persons interested in said estate by publishing such notice in the Grand Island Independent, a legal newspaper printed in said County, for three weeks prior to said day of hearing; and it appears by proof on file that said notice was given as ordered by Court and that no objections to said final account were made or filed.

Upon examination of the record and the evidence in this matter and being duly advised in the premises, the Court finds as follows:

FIRST

That Mattie Stromer departed this life on the 26th day of December, 1952, at her residence in Grand Island, Hall County, Nebraska, testate, and at the time of her death she was a resident of Hall County, Nebraska.

SECOND

That on the 30th day of December, 1952, Gertie Weininger, Richard Stromer, Caroline S. Kosal, Ray Stromer and I Vera Ray Kerr filed in this Court an instrument purporting to be the Last Will and Testament and Codicil thereto of said Mattie Stromer, deceased, wherein said Caroline S. Kosal was named Executrix, and a petition offering said Will and Codicil thereto for probate, and on the 30th day of December, 1952, an order of this Court was made therein assigning the 28th day
