At a Session of the County Court held in and for said County of Hall in the State of Nebraska, this 9th day of September, 1953.

Present: Charles Bossart, County Judge.

BE IT REMEMBERED that on the 11th day of August, 1953, Rubie E. Bancroft, Administratrix of the Estate of Ella Paro, also known as Ellen Paro, deceased, filed in this Court her final account as such Administratrix, and a petition praying that said account be allowed, for a decree of heirship, determination of inheritance tax, settlement and distribution of estate, and discharge.

For these purposes the 9th day of September, 1953, at 10 o'clock a.m., at the County Court Room in said County was assigned as the time and place for hearing said petition, examining and allowing said account; and it was ordered that notice of the pendency of said petition be given to all persons interested in said estate by publishing such notice in the Grand Island Independent, a legal newspaper printed in said County for three weeks prior to said day of hearing, and it appears by proof on file that said notice was given as ordered by Court and that no objections to said final account have been made or filed.

Upon examination of the record and the evidence in this matter and being duly advised in the premises, the Court finds as follows:

FIRST

That Ella Paro, also known as Ellen Paro, departed this life on the 4th day of February, 1953, in Grand Island, Hall County, Nebraska, intestate, and at the time of her death she was a resident of Hall County, Nebraska.

SECOND

That on the 13th day of February, 1953, Blanche E. Jackson, a daughter of said Ella Paro, also known as Ellen Paro, deceased, filed in this Court a petition praying for the appointment of Rubie E. Bancroft as Administratrix of the Estate of said deceased, and on the 13th day of February, 1953, an order of this Court was made therein assigning the 12th day of March, 1953, at 10 o'clock a.m., at the County Court Room in said County as the time and place for hearing said petition, and ordering that notice of the pendency of said petition and hearing thereon
